

# Accessing fertility care

Your fertility coverage through  
Blue Shield of California



## Coverage begins with 2026 plan renewals and new enrollments

California Senate Bill 729 (SB 729) requires coverage for infertility diagnosis and treatment services for eligible members with an employer plan that starts or renews in 2026 and beyond. Coverage details may vary by employer group based on prior plan designs. Check your *Evidence of Coverage* (EOC) for specific benefit information.



### What's included

- Coverage for fertility services, including up to three completed oocyte (egg) retrievals and unlimited embryo transfers (using single-embryo transfer when recommended and medically appropriate)
- Coverage for in vitro fertilization (IVF), intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI) for male factor infertility, and intrauterine insemination (IUI)
- Services provided by in-network fertility specialists



### Who is eligible?

Members covered under fully-insured employer health plans\* subject to SB 729 will have access to fertility benefits starting with plan years that begin or renew in 2026 and beyond.

## How to use your benefits

- Confirm your benefits by reviewing your plan documents or logging in to your account at **blueshieldca.com**.

- Ask your doctor for a referral if your plan requires one.
- Bring your Blue Shield member ID card to your appointment.
