



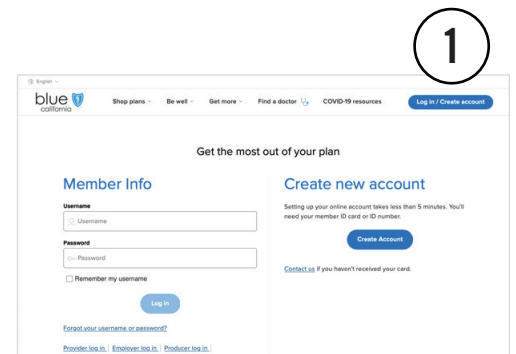

You've come to the right place!

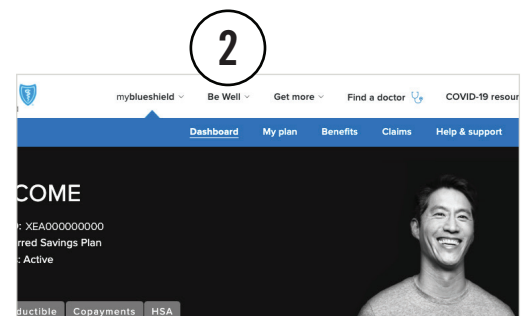
1 Register or log in

Register for an account or **log in** to your existing account at blueshieldca.com/login.



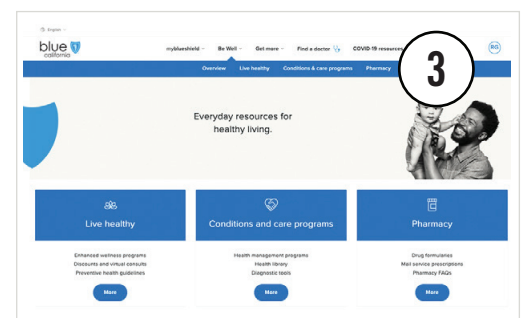
2 Click **Be Well**

Once you **log in**, you'll be directed to your dashboard where you'll click **Be Well** in the navigation bar.



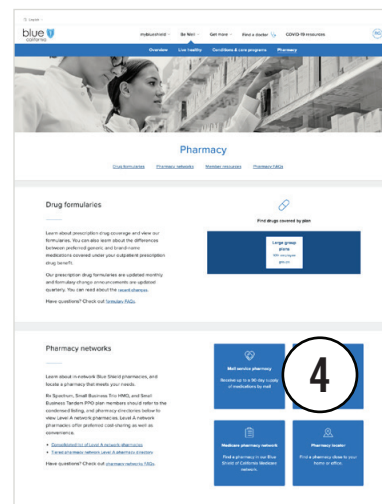
3 Click **Pharmacy**

Once you're on the **Be Well** page, look for the **Pharmacy** link on the secondary navigation bar.



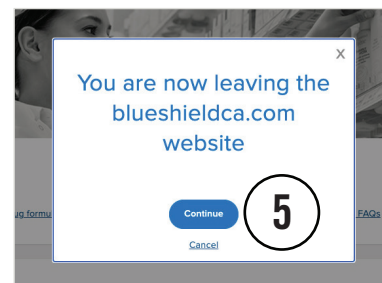
4 Select Mail service pharmacy

You're almost there – once selected, click **Continue** on the popup window to be redirected to the **CVS Caremark** site.



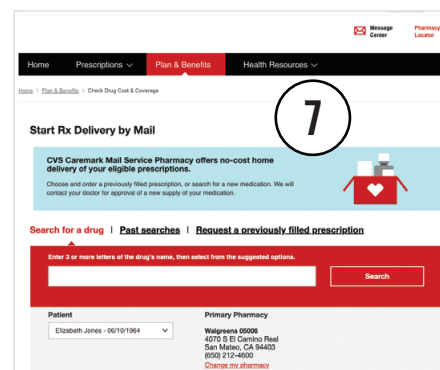
6 Continue to the CVS Caremark site
