# How to access CVS Caremark® Mail Service Pharmacy

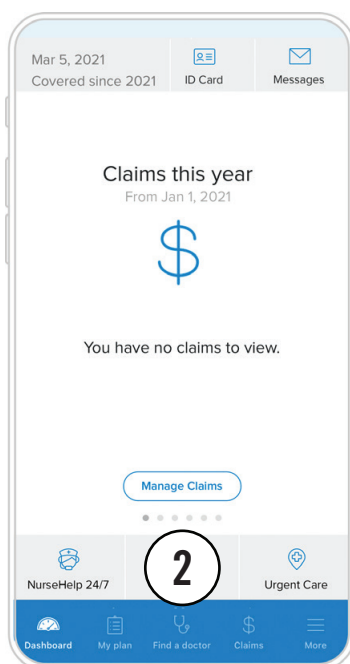
Looking to get your prescriptions delivered to your home?

## Register or log in

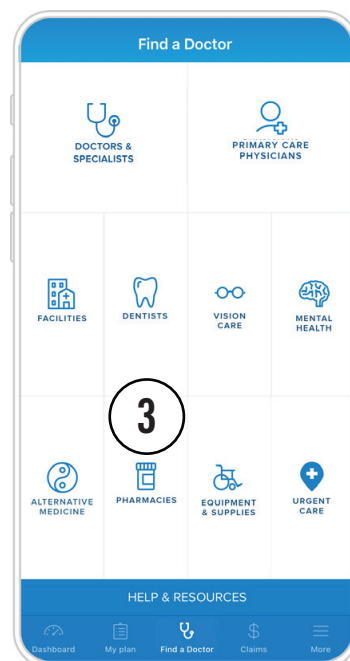
First things first – you need to **register** for an account or **log in** to your existing account.

## Click *Find a doctor*

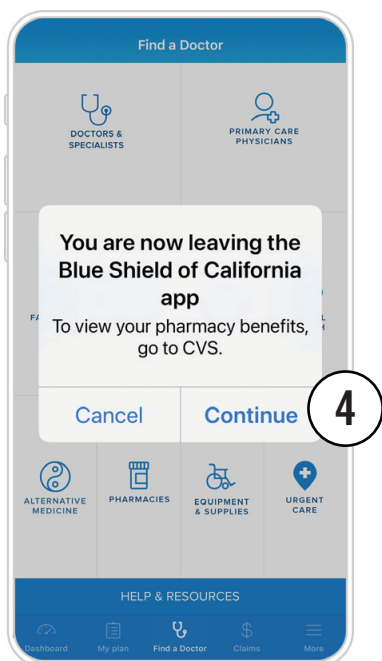
Once you log in, tap **Find a doctor** in the navigation bar. For iOS users, the navigation bar is at the bottom. For Android users, the navigation bar is on the left.

## Select **PHARMACIES**

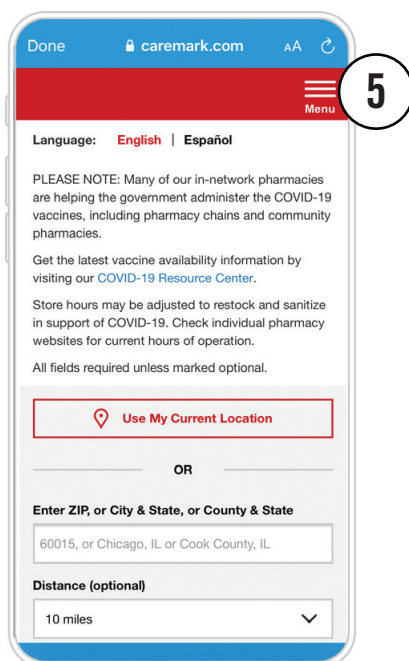
Tap **PHARMACIES** under **Find a Doctor**.

### Tap **Continue**

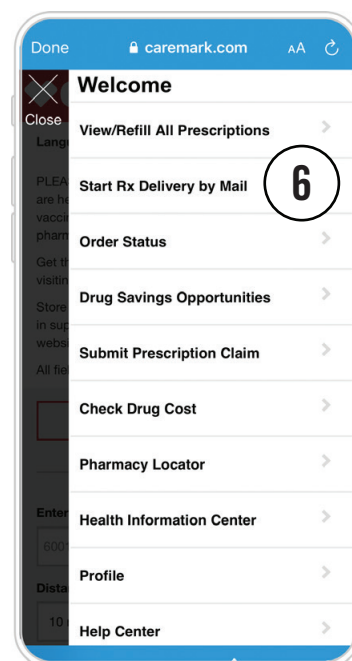
